Walter Austin Obituary

Walter E. Austin, 94, died on Oct. 30, 2002, at St. Luke's Hospital, in Duluth. Born in Vienna, Austria on Sept. 8, 1908, and a World War II Holocaust survivor, Walter resided in Duluth for over 60 years and worked at Minnesota Woolen Company for more than 30 years. He was an avid stamp and coin collector, photographer, and world traveler. In retirement, he became an accomplished painter and served as a docent at Glensheen for several years. Walter was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Irma, in 1978, after nearly 40 years of marriage. Surviving Mr. Austin are his daughter Ruth (Arthur) Hafner of Glenview, Ill.; and his son Peter (Bonney) Austin of Duluth; grandchildren Zachary, Ethan (Melissa), and Jeremy Hafner, Tamar (Jack) Waller, and Bryan, Jonathan, Nicholas and Alexandra Austin, and great-grandchildren Tyler, Trent, and Rachel Waller.
