



# Bob Baldinger

Robert Baldinger<sup>l</sup>, age 97, passed away December 7, 2024 in Mendota Heights, MN. He graduated from Mechanic Arts High School before enlisting in the Navy in 1945, where he worked as a baker. After returning to St. Paul, Bob met Estelle, the love of his life. They were married for 64 years.

Bob spent his whole career in the family bakery business, helping it grow from a small storefront into a commercial baking enterprise selling buns and breads to restaurants across the United States and Canada. Even after he “retired,” he still went into the bakery as often as he could, just to check up on things and offer his perspective.

Outside of work, Bob was committed to his family and to the Jewish community. He was a back row Shabbat regular at Temple of Aaron and morning minyan regular at Beth Jacob, participating and helping lead services. He took tremendous pride in seeing his family succeed, and was always ready to offer his special brand of advice to help them take the next steps in their careers.

Shiva is scheduled for Tuesday, December 10, Wednesday, December 11, and Thursday, December 12, 7:00 pm at Temple of Aaron; Saturday, December 14, 7:00 pm at Steve and Wendy’s; and Sunday, December 15, 7:00 pm at David and Christy’s.
