Norton Cohen Obituary

NORTON R. COHEN, 81, of Louisville, died Saturday, July 15, 2006. He was a graduate of Male High School and attended the University of Miami and the University of Louisville. Norton was a veteran of World War II, having served as a tank gunner in Normandy before being transferred to write and direct an Army show entitled "For Men Only." He served in the European theater until the war's end, and returned home to later become President of the Acme Paper Stock Company, a member of the Temple, and a member of the board at Jewish Hospital.
