Louis DeChristopher Obituary

Louis DeChristopher 1924 - 2007 FEEDING HILLS - Louis DeChristopher, 82, of Mill Street, entered into eternal rest on Sunday, August 19, 2007. Born in West Springfield, he moved to Agawam in 1962. Louis worked for thirty-two years for the former Rexnord Chain Company retiring in 1979. He was a World War II Army veteran, receiving the Purple Heart and the Silver Star. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Barcomb-Trowbridge Post 6714. Louis was known by and will be remembered by many as the "man with the firewood for sale on Mill Street". He leaves his wife of fifty-seven years, Rita M. (Wocel) DeChristopher, a son and his wife, David E. and Bonnie DeChristopher of Agawam, two daughters and their husbands, Diane and Roger Reizovic of Taunton, Debbie and Todd Mekler of Raynham, and two grandchildren, Audrey Mekler and Adam Louis Mekler.
