DUBESTER (NECHAMA RACHEL PRIMAKOW), BELOVED DAUGHTER, SISTER, WIFE, MOTHER, GRANDMOTHER (BUBBIE), AND GREAT-BUBBIE, AGE 90, DIED PEACEFULLY AT HER HOME, SARA CHUDNOW JEWISH HOME, IN MEQUON, WISCONSIN ON DECEMBER 20, 2013. PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER PARENTS REBECCA (PUMP) AND ABRAHAM PRIMAKOW, BY HER HUSBAND, DAVID J. DUBESTER, WHO PASSED AWAY ON NOVEMBER 11, 1988, BY HER YOUNGER SISTERS; DOLLY (PRIMAKOW) SUMBERG AND LEAH (PRIMAKOW) FEINMAN. SURVIVED BY HER CHILDREN, FOUR GRAND-CHILDREN, TWO GREAT-GRAND-CHILDREN; HER SISTER & BROTHER-IN-LAW; NEPHEWS & NIECE; COUSINS; (Names withheld for privacy).

ROSE WAS BORN IN MILWAUKEE, WI. ON SEPTEMBER 1, 1923. AFTER HER MARRIAGE TO DAVID J. DUBESTER (OSHKOSH), THEY MOVED TO SUPERIOR, WI. WHERE THEY RAISED THEIR CHILDREN. DAVID WAS A PHARMACIST. ROSE WORKED ALONG SIDE HER HUSBAND AT THEIR PHARMACY, DUBESTER DRUGS ON 12TH AND TOWER.

ROSE'S LIFE WAS LIVED FULLY AND ACTIVELY, SHE REMAINED SELF-RELIANT THROUGH MOST OF HER LIFE AND FIERCELY INDEPENDENTLY THROUGH ALL OF IT. ROSE'S LIFE WAS SUSTAINED BY INTELLECTUAL ADVENTURE AND CURIOSITY, FORWARD THINKING, ZIONISTIC AND HOPEFUL IDEAS. SHE WAS AN INCREDIBLE READER AND HER QUEST FOR KNOWLEDGE WAS ENDLESS. ROSE WAS A FABULOUS LIBRARIAN AT HER SYNAGOGUE, TEMPLE BETH EL, IN SUPERIOR, WISCONSIN FOR MANY YEARS WHERE SHE TAUGHT THE

CONGREGANTS OF ALL AGES THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING PROUD OF THEIR JUDIASM AND BEING VERY KNOWLEDGABLE. SHE WAS ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN MANY ORGANIZATIONS (LOCALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY) SUCH AS HADASSAH (LIFE TIME MEMBER FOR OVER 50 YEARS), WOMEN'S LEAGUE, SICK LOAN CUPBOARD, SUPERIOR, WI., ISRAELI BONDS, AND MANY MORE. ROSE LOVED JEWISH MUSIC, HUMOR, THEATRE, AND CULTURAL EVENTS. SHE CONTINUALLY SUPPORTED HUNDREDS OF COMMUNITY AND WORLD-WIDE NON-JEWISH AND JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS. ROSE TRULY TAUGHT US THE IMPORTANCE OF FRIENDSHIP, FAMILY, JUDIASM, ZIONISM, TOGETHERNESS, LEADERSHIP, BEING WELL-READ, AND GIVING CHARITY. HER GOOD NAME AND PROUD LEGACY WILL LIVE ON THROUGH THESE BEAUTIFUL VALUES SHE HAS INSTILLED IN US AND OUR LOVING MEMORIES WE WERE GIVEN.
