MRS. N. D. GOLDFARB.

Mrs. Malya Goldfarb, wife of Nathaniel D. Goldfarb, died suddenly yesterday morning of a heart attack at their residence, 87 Lee Avenue, Brooklyn, in her seventy-eighth year. Born in Austria, she had lived in this country for about forty years. Besides her husband she leaves eleven children and thirty grandchildren. Among her sons are Rabbi Israel Goldfarb of Congregation Israel Anshe Eneth, Brooklyn, and an instructor at the Jewish Theological Seminary; Samuel E. Goldfarb of Seattle, a composer, and Albert Goldfarb, president of Temple Emanu-El of Staten Island. Mrs. Goldfarb was the founder of the Goldfarb Society, one of the first family groups of its kind in the United States, and secretary of the Noshin Rachmonoyoth
