Harold N. Gordon, 72, of Avila Beach died Monday, April 11, 1994, at his residence.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday at Congregation Beth David in San Luis Obispo. Cremation has taken place at Arroyo Valley Crematory in Arroyo Grande. Burial will take place at Lady Family-Sutcliffe Cemetery in San Luis Obispo.

Mr. Gordon was born Jan. 2, 1922, in Ely, Minn. He graduated from the University of Minnesota School of Medicine in 1945. He practiced obstetrics and gynecology in Yuma, Ariz., from 1953 to 1971 and then retired from private practice to serve as medical director of Planned Parenthood in Phoenix until 1973. He was drug and alcohol abuse medical director at St. Luke's Hospital in Phoenix from 1976 to 1983. In 1984, he moved to Avila Beach.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Margery Gordon of Avila Beach; five daughters, Robyn Metchik and her husband, Paul, of Oceano, Dana Gross and her husband, Bob, of Key Largo, Fla., Wendy Garner and her husband, Sandy, of Arlington Heights, Ill., Dale Gordon of Ventura, and Kendall Marshall of Oceano; a son, Dr. Josh Gordon and his wife, Dr. Elizabeth Gordon, of Silver Springs, Md.; two brothers; three sisters-in-law; and nine grandchildren.
