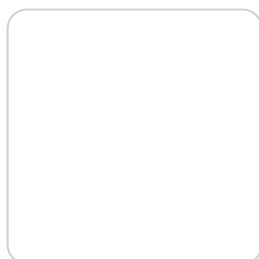
Sally Hallock Obituary
