FUNERAL AT APPLETON

Mr. and Mrs. Max Wirth left this morning for Appleton to attend the funeral of the former's brother-in-law, David F. Hammel, who died at his home in this city Monday afternoon. The Appleton Crescent contained, in part, the following in regard to the deceased: "Mr. Hammel was a native of Appleton, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Hammel. For a number of years he had been a member of the firm of Marshall & Hammel and under the aldermanic system he represented the Second ward in the city council. Mr. Hammel was prominent in the local fraternal order being a member of the Masonic Knights of Pythias and Elk lodge.
