Leon also served his country joining the Army. He was stationed in the Philippines.

Leon worked for Western Electric/AT&T in Duluth, Oklahoma, Colorado and Seoul Korea, and retired after 32 years and was able to move up in the company to be the CFO. He also went to Seoul, Korea to set up the new facility there. Leon and Jean proceeded to travel and visit family and friends all over

the United States.

Leon is preceded in death by his parents Charles and Marcia Kassmir, brother Gerald and sister-in-law Rosemary Kassmir.

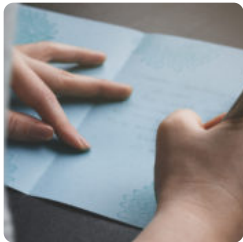
