






Obituary: SA cruise doyen passes on

"Raymond and I met in 1996, when he had just returned from a Royal Carribbean cruise, and he told me in no uncertain terms that he would start a business specialising in retailing cruise holidays, which

he would name 'Just Cruising', and he asked for my support. I did not have high hopes at the time, but I offered Raymond my full support. And within a month, he had proven me wrong! Within a few years, Just Cruising had become our top customer with a turnover at least double that of our second-best account
