Roslyn A. Marver, 98, of Greenwood, Indiana, formerly of Evansville, Indiana, passed away on May 30, 2016. She died peacefully with her family by her side.

She was born on December 19, 1917, in Frazee, Minnesota, to the late Samuel and Judith (Rubin) Alcalay.

Roslyn married Harold Marver on January 12, 1941, joined together until his passing in October of 1994.

Mrs. Marver is survived by her two sons, Jerry Marver, of Greenwood, Ind., and Joel Marver, of Sarasota, Fla.

She moved to Evansville after World War II, starting Bondstreet Wholesale Jewelers (later Marver Brothers Jewelers) with her husband along with her brother-in-law, Sherman Marver and sister-in-law, Idell Marver. Mrs. Marver contributed to the war effort, working for the Army throughout, accompanying her husband to many locales.

Her contributions to the Evansville area were many. She was past President of the PTA at Dexter Grade School. She was a volunteer to the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra. Roslyn was a member of and served on numerous committees of Hadassah and the Sisterhood of Temple Adath B'nai Israel. She was an accomplished bridge player and enjoyed canasta and mah jongg. She was a prolific reader throughout her life. It was

only the Great Depression and World War II that prevented her from finishing her final semester at the University of Minnesota.

During Roslyn's high school years, she studied journalism and her personal interview with Fred Waring of big band fame was a highlight.

Mrs. Marver pressed one piece of information to her sons, to remember that everyone has a story to tell and you should be good listeners.

A graveside service will be conducted at 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday at Mt. Carmel Cemetery in Evansville.




