Scott Alan Miller, 70, of Champlin, Minnesota, passed away on March 2, 2024. Preceded in death by his parents, Maurice and Nancy; and brother, Brad; he leaves behind a legacy of love, compassion, and unwavering commitment to his family and community.

Survived by his children with his late wife, Lynda: Heidi, Sean, Mark, Aimee, Sarah, and Lindsey (with many grandchildren). He is also survived by his former wife, Lisa; and children, Robby and Max.

Scott was born in Rochester, Minnesota on May 14, 1953, relocating to the Twin Cities area by his high school years. Scott's impact extended far beyond his family, spending a majority of his life teaching generations of students in early childhood education at Beth El Synagogue in St. Louis Park, and FCDC in Plymouth. He was also an active member of the medical community — serving as an EMT in his prior years, and a volunteer with North Memorial Hospital in his later ones.
