

Leonard Zneimer Dies at Age 60

Leonard Zneimer, 60, of Rhinebeck, N.Y., died Tuesday in Philadelphia.

He was an internationally recognized author and lecturer in the field of retarded children and was on a lecture tour in Philadelphia when he died.

Mr. Zneimer also was vice president of the National Association of Schools for Retarded Children.

Surviving are his widow, the former Erna Zwilling; son, Edward, Rhinebeck; daughter, Mrs. Annette Spiegel, Ballston Spa, N.Y.; brother, Stephan, Dallas; mother, Mrs. Gertrude Zneimer, Stanford, Conn.

Funeral was held Wednesday with interment in Temple Beth El Cemetery, Poughkeepsie, N.Y.
